Thank you for your participation in last Thursday evening's seminar at Crest Hollow Country Club. As you are well aware, the new tax act is extremely complex especially when dealing with the incredibly complicated Section 199A provisions of the new law.

Upon review of the evaluation forms, which we take seriously, it is clear to me, Robert Barnett, and the NCCPAP leadership, that the additional discussion and examples we had planned to present during session II are in fact necessary to ensure that you will be comfortable (if that is even possible) regarding the Section 199A provisions.
